## HUNGER CALL TO ACTION:

September is Hunger Action Month. Nearly 49 million people in America face hunger. That is 1 in 6 of the U.S. population – including more than 1 in 5 children.

In Volusia and Flagler Counties many of our neighbors are struggling to feed their families and you can help by accepting the Hunger Call to Action: Donate \$1 each day for a week Sept. 9-15 = \$7 to feed a family of 4 for 7-10 meals. With all of us doing our share we can help to make sure the families in our neighborhoods do not go hungry.

## Give \$1 A Day For A Week – To Feed A Neighbors Family

### WHO, WHAT, WHERE?

The Community Foundation of East Central Florida and a coalition of community leaders invites individuals, civic groups, students, faith organizations and local corporations to participate in our **"Feed Our Neighbors Week - Challenge for Hunger"**. We want the whole community to be involved for one week to help raise money for our local agencies providing food. **Money raised in each county will be granted out to nonprofits working in that county, staying local.**

Groups can participate in our "Hunger Challenge". We invite civic organizations, students, corporations and faith groups to raise the most money for their category. Those who raise the most money will receive a "Heroes for Hunger Award". The corporation raising the most money for food during the week of September 9-15th will receive recognition as our "Corporate Heroes for Hunger".





# Food4Kids Spirit Elementary

Hunger and malnutrition contribute to a number of negative health issues and can affect a child's ability to learn.

**Food4Kids Spirit Elementary was created this year in order to provide hungry children with food each weekend during the school year.**

**How does it work?** Every Friday children who participate in the program take home a backpack on wheels with food for weekend meals for all of the children in that family. Every Monday they return their backpack for the next week.

- Canned meats (tuna, chicken, etc)
- Dry or canned pasta
- Dry or canned beans
- Canned soup
- Canned vegetables or beans
- Milk (shelf-stable)
- Juice Boxes
- Macaroni and cheese (boxed)
- Peanut butter, jelly
- Pudding cups
- Fruit cups
- Cereal or oatmeal
- Granola bars
- Cheese or peanut butter crackers

Food for the backpacks is securely stored. Each Thursday, volunteers will fill the backpacks for pick-up by the children on Friday.
