In then near future we will be able to help clients with things like rent and utility deposits, security deposits as well as monthly stipends for individuals who just need a little bit of extra help each month. We will also be able to use transitional housing which will help with people coming out of jail or people who need to get into a hotel until we can help them get into a more permanent housing situation. • CAN Community Health has added a new ARNP to their staff, Kate Rodgers. She will be working Mondays and Tuesdays. National Testing event will be held June 24th at New Church Family. There will be a cookout that starts at 12:00pm. They will also be testing at Hamburger Mary’s on June 27th. • OCCN will be at the Dickerson Center on June 27th from 11am-5pm hosting a testing event. They will be at Walgreens on Beville from 10am -7pm testing as well. OCCN is also doing no cost STD testing via swabs. If clients want blood draws they are referred to VCHD. • SMA is now offering rapid HIV testing. |
