**Daytona Beach, Fla.** — The Florida Department of Health in Volusia County (DOH-Volusia) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels the following location:

**Silver Beach**  
**Near Silver Beach Ave. beach access**  
**Daytona Beach, FL, 32118**

Tests completed on October 3, 2025, indicate that the water quality at Silver Beach shows an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines. Test results are available at [FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches](https://FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches).
