
7th Annual Keeping Hope: Overdose Awareness and Remembrance Day

International Overdose Awareness Day acknowledges the grief felt by families and friends and remembers those who have died due to drug overdose. The day helps reduce the stigma of Substance Use Disorder (SUD), showing that recovery is possible and that overdoses can be prevented.

- Tables for Overdose Response and Reversal training, Narcan, Harm Reduction and recovery resources.

- Remembrance Ceremony and Walk to Remember.
- Food, children's activities, memorial crafting, Promises of Tomorrow, and Recovery art display.
- Speeches from family members who have lost a loved one to overdose, overdose survivors, and a short video message from the medical examiner, James Fulcher, MD.
