## **Utility Providers Restoring Power to Volusia County**

**VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA** – While utility companies continue restoring power as quickly as possible, outages continue to affect residents in Volusia County following the impact of Hurricane Milton. As of 2 p.m. today, Oct. 12, the number of outages reported by each utility provider is:

Clay Electric: 114 customers
 Duke Energy: 25,000 customers

Florida Power & Light: 49,710 customers
 NSB Utilities Commission: 5,899 customers
