There will be staff at the store that will assist patients in getting linked to care with programs such as the Ryan White program, nPEP, PrEP etc. Once the privacy screens are installed the site will have space open for community partners and organizations to preform testing.

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		<p>Priorities and Allocations Voting – Ryan White will no longer be using the AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance (Not ADAP) line item, the allocation percentage that was assigned to that line item was distributed among the other line items based on the current spending trends. CAN is working with the Department of Health to set up a specific day to administer vaccines to Ryan White clients at no charge. Program 17 is now requiring an administration fee for vaccines.
