Volusia County, FL — The Florida Department of Health in Volusia County (DOH-Volusia) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels at the following location:

**the Dunlawton Avenue Beach Vehicle Ramp
Daytona Beach Shores, FL
and
Toronita Avenue Beach Park,
4200 S. Atlantic Ave.
Wilbur-By-the-Sea, FL**

Tests completed on Feb. 23, 2026, indicate that the water quality at the Dunlawton Avenue Beach Vehicle Ramp and Toronita Avenue Beach Park shows an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines. Test results are available at FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches.
